

Adult PICC/Ultrasound Workshop in Atlanta August 22-23, 2024


Join us for two days of intensive PICC training!

QUESTION

There seems to be a lot of debate at my facility about acceptable tip location post PICC line placement. To my knowledge the ideal spot for the tip to sit is the cavoatrial junction. Some feel that the right atrium is an acceptable location as well, which is where some of ours end up sitting. What does current literature show on this?

ANSWER


This is a controversial subject with an interesting history. In the mid-1980s, the FDA ruled that CVADs required confirmation and should not be advanced into the heart. In response, all the catheter manufacturers (except for dialysis) added SVC/IVC only to their instructions for use and package inserts.

While many physicians and clinicians are placing catheter tips within the right atrium, this is an offlabel use that opens you up to liability if something goes awry. There is not enough evidence of the benefit of right atrial placement vs vena cava placement to warrant such a placement against FDA and manufacturer recommendations.

INS Standards of Practice state vena cava or caval atrial junction placement, and other organizations recommend the same for non-dialysis catheters.

Once the evidence increases in support of right atrial placement, INS Standards and manufacturer guidelines may change - but not now. I recommend a full literature review prior to making a policy or practice change to positioning in the right atrium.
