Plan ahead for a successful year of continuing education with individual or multiuser access learning opportunities.



#### QUESTION

My patient was not able to receive a PICC due to areas of vessels restricting advancement of the catheter. Each attempt resulted in the catheter curling back. I was able to localize the areas of blockage and would like to consider direct Axillary vein access. Can Axillary vein access with superior vena cava tip positioning be used for infusions of Vancomycin for 6 weeks or more?

#### **ANSWER**

Axillary placement is certainly acceptable for infusion of vancomycin when the terminal tip is located in the superior vena cava (SVC). Training is required with precepted insertions since the Axillary vein is deeper and positioned below the Axillary Artery. Good ultrasound needle guidance skills are necessary for successful access.

As long as the terminal tip of the catheter is in the distal portion of the SVC near or at the Caval Atrial junction, infusions of irritating medications such as Vancomycin should be safe for 6 weeks or more. The Axillary central catheter should be used and managed with an antimicrobial dressing in the same manner as a subclavian central venous catheter.
